- 4.3 Summary of 18-19 Student Recruitment Open House: Eleven potential new students attended the open house. Five students would be entering grade 3-4, three into the 6th grade and 3 into the 9th grade. RJ Burns spoke with families about the ferry, Mike and Chris did a tour for the families with Christian and the student panel did a nice job with the questions put to them. A huge thank you to Aly and Julie for organizing it!
- 4.4 Purchase of Custodial/Maintainer Supplies and Equipment: The tools Edguardo needs to do his job have been discussed and will be purchased for him. He has already saved the school a great deal of money this school year by quickly making repairs to the monkey bars, the leak in the water fountain and a light in the teacher's room.
- 4.5 17-18 Rural Schools Grant Change in State Aid Funding Formulas: Due to changes in Federal Law No Child Left Behind has been changed to Every Student Succeeds Act and the funding has changed. FIS no longer meets the financial (poverty) requirements as a rural school which is now to show 20% poverty/students eligible to receive free and reduced lunch.
- 4.6 18-19 School Calendar Options (First Reading): Chris Dollar discussed the 4 options with the board. After a lengthy discussion he will rework options 3 and 4 to present next month for the second reading.
- 4.7 Process for Development of a Capital Needs Plan for District: We need to look at the big picture once the 2016-2017 audit is finalized.
